Dear Russell,

In Oral Questions 13 February I offered to write to you about the National Infrastructure Commission in relation to our work around Brexit.

The National Infrastructure Commission for Wales' remit is to identify Wales' future infrastructure needs for the next 5-30 years. To do so, the Commission will need to consider the long term implications of Brexit, including implications for the movement of goods. The Government will provide appropriate information and engage with the Commission to enable it to fulfil its remit.

However, the short term implications of Brexit are outside the scope of the Commission. The Government would not wish to divert the Commission from its intended purpose to provide advice on Wales' long term need for infrastructure.
