Environment (Wales) Bill

In my view:

- Most of the provisions of the Environment (Wales) Bill, introduced on 11 May 2015, would be within the legislative competence of the National Assembly for Wales.
- Sections 6, 11(2) and 21 would not be within competence. This is because these provisions require the consent of the Secretary of State to bring them within the competence of the National Assembly for Wales and this necessary consent has not been obtained at this time.
