The Smoke Control Areas (Authorised Fuels) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2000

Background

Schedule 1 to the Smoke Control Areas (Authorised Fuels) Regulations 1991 lists proprietary fuels which can be burnt in smoke control areas.

The present Regulations amend that list. The amendments add two fuels and make alterations in consequence of changes in the manufacture of other named fuels.

The same amendments have been made for England in SI 2000 No. 1077. This was made on 17 April 2000 and came into force on 9 May 2000.
